How can I stop my staff from leaving?

The true answer? You can't, **BUT**, you can make it a harder decision for them to do so. Here are 3 key points:

ENVIRONMENT

The most important thing is to be able to create an environment for your staff where they feel comfortable and confident. This will provide them with the confidence to speak to you about their feelings regarding their role, progression, and an insight to if they can see a future within the company. Their answers and body language within that situation will provide you with a good indication if there should be any cause for concern.

This secure environment will provide you with the opportunity to show your staff that you are willing to invest in their development and explore opportunities within the company. It will also provide staff the openness to discuss any problems or reasons that may mean their position within the company is either not suitable for them or ideal for the long term

DEVELOPMENT

You often find that one of the main reasons employees leave is due to them wanting to better develop their careers.

SIGNS

There are some signs that you can look out for to indicate that an employee might be thinking of leaving, which are:

- Are they taking more time off, late in, leaving early?
- Their Behaviour
- Questions on their contract or employment
- Rumours

If you find an employee showing any of the above signs, use this as a chance to do a causal check in with them and ask:

- How are they?
- How are they finding their job?
- Do they have any worries/concerns?
